Education- \$50 or \$100

(WMED001- WMED002)

Provide education for a child for only \$50 a term, or \$100 for a year. Education provides children with the tools they need for the future. In Uganda, a recently built school currently has around 100 children enrolled that previously had little access to education.



School Supplies \$25

(WMED003)


In Pakistan, Son of God Christian School, provides education and meals to local children while their parents work. New supplies are rarely bought since most resources are used to feed the students.



Teacher's Salary - \$90

(WMED024)

Education access in Uganda can be expensive, and often children are unable to afford the tuition. The Davey Boger School was built in 2025 and provides affordable education to the local village. Assisting with a monthly teacher salary ensures that their education continues. “Train a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.” Proverbs 22:6



Pastoral Training \$100

(WMED004)

As 2 Timothy says “faithful men who will be able to teach others also” are critical to the Church.

Pastors lead services, provide support for their congregations, and are the feet of Jesus.

Providing proper training to these men ensures they have knowledge of the Bible and are able to lead effectively.



Help a build a Church \$10-1,000

(WMCH005-010)

Many congregations in Burundi, Tanzania, and Congo worship in open or shared spaces. Sending funds to help build a church can secure land, materials, and labor.





Pastor's Monthly Salary \$50

(WMCH013)

Rev. Nicholas Mulero was delighted to know he could minister full time with salary support. When you provide a monthly salary, these ministers can focus on what really matters, tending to their congregations without having to worry about their financial stability.

Buy a Motorcycle- \$750

(WMOP023)

In parts of rural Africa, road conditions and economic instability makes it difficult for pastor's to care for their flocks. Boda bodas are small motorcycles that easily and quickly navigate difficult road conditions. Bishop Bamuwamye uses his daily to visit the people in his care across Uganda.



Meet Eddy Nakalala

Rev. Eddy Nakalala serves as the president of the Congo Classis of the E&R Synod. He and his wife Neema, live in Uvira, Democratic Republic of Congo with their six children. He studied at Lutheran Theological Seminary in Tshwane, South Africa. He was ordained three years ago after serving a two-year vicarage and many years as a lay pastor. At this time, he serves two congregations across the country. He speaks ten languages including Swahili, French, and English.




Orphanage Support \$100

(WMOP012)

Dennis and his father help take care of twelve children. There are three rooms in the orphanage. One for boys to sleep, one for girls to sleep, and one for them to learn. Each day they are served communal meals and have class in the orphanage since access to formal education is limited. It is difficult to feed and clothe each of these children, however Dennis reminds us “There’s nothing quite like the smiles of children! Their joy reminds us daily that caring is a gift and that growth happens best in an environment filled with love, laughter, and hope.”




Give a Bible- \$20


